# WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

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This policy:

- Shows the commitment of the management of Sarvjan India Fintech Pvt Ltd and workers to health and safety
- Aims to remove or reduce the risks to the health, safety and welfare of all workers, contractors and visitors, and anyone else who may be affected by our business operations
- Aims to ensure all work activities are done safely.

### □ Responsibilities

Management (the supervisor and / or manager) is responsible for providing and maintaining:

- A safe, clean and healthy working environment
- Safe systems of work
- Facilities for the welfare of all workers
- Any information, instruction, training and supervision needed to make sure that all workers are safe from injury and risks to their health
- Ensuring all the workers conduct their work in a safe manner

Workers are responsible for:

- Ensuring their own personal health and safety, and that of others in the workplace
- Complying with any reasonable directions (such as safe work procedures, wearing personal protective equipment) for their own health and safety
- Ensure that the personal vehicles used for field visits are maintained properly & serviced regularly ie are fit to use.
- Workers to have a valid driving license for the appropriate vehicle
- Workers to ensure that the vehicle has a valid nonpolluting certificate at all times. All employees to secure the same at their own cost
- Workers to ensure that private vehicles used for official purpose have a valid insurance when on the road. All employees to ensure that this is done at their own cost
- Ensure that the air pressure in the tyres of two wheelers/ Vehicles used is as per specified limits
- Mandatory use of helmet by all employees while travelling on two wheelers
- Triple riding on two wheelers is strictly prohibited and not allowed under any circumstances
- Compulsory for pillion riders to wear a helmet as well
- Employees to observe all traffic rules and speed limits at all times
- Employees to drive safely within the specified speed limits.

### Implications

In case of violations of the EHS the following will be treated as per the Sarvjans Zero Tolerance Policy

Not wearing Helmet at the time of duty Triple Riding on a two-wheeler for official purpose Rash driving and not observing traffic rules Riding without valid insurance or driving license
